Ampersand Book Studio – a private press established by Tristan Reader during the early days of the pandemic – is in the initial stages of producing a fine press edition of Patrick O'Brian's novel Master and Commander. This 360-page book is being printed by Tristan at Betts Printing in Tuscon's Lost Barrio neighborhood. It features fine European laid paper - from France's Arches mill and handmade from Velké Losiny in the Czech Republic – and is printed in two colors using a 13x18 Heidelberg "Windmill" press. For more than 80 years, Betts Printing in Tucson, Arizona has combined old-school craftsmanship with evolving printing technologies.
